- Many of our destinations will be opened exclusively for the MTFCI. These sites are not open to the public at all or normally closed at this time.
- ✓ Our center of operations will be the renowned Dearborn Inn.
- ✓ The Dearborn Inn regular room rate of \$159 has been reduced for the MTFCI to \$119 per night, plus tax. This same rate applies if you wish to extend your stay.
- ✓ It is suggested that distant travelers fly to/from Detroit Metro Airport (DTW). DTW is about a 15-minute taxi ride to the Dearborn Inn.
- Three meals will be included with your registration:

  - Saturday lunch at the Detroit Institute of Arts 0
  - Saturday banquet and MTFCI Annual Meeting at Dearborn Inn 0

- IMPORTANT! Our busy schedule does NOT include a visit to The Henry Ford Museum, which is across the street from the Dearborn Inn. Visiting The Henry Ford Museum often requires 1-2 days. The museum is open 7 days per week, 9:30 am -5:00 pm. Cost is about \$20. You may also want to spend time at the Benson Ford Research Library which is open Monday through Friday, 9:30 am - 5:00 pm. There is no entry fee for the Benson Ford. We highly suggest that you extend your visit to Dearborn if you would like to explore these great venues!
